CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT DANIEL D. REED

Chief Master Sergeant Daniel D. Reed is the Career Field Manager for Military Training, Second Air Force, Keesler Air Force Base, MS. He is responsible to the Second Air Force Commander for military training in over 390 Air Force specialties through 1,900 courses graduating 150,000 students annually across four training wings, nine training groups and 103 field training detachments. He develops and executes Military Training Instructor (MTI) and Military Training Leader (MTL) Corps' training qualification, determining course requirements to include evaluating manpower standards and ensuring training is conducted in compliance with higher headquarters directives and policies. He is also responsible for recruitment, selection and training of 610 MTIs and 410 MTLs across 49 locations.

Chief Master Sergeant Reed entered the Air Force in August 2000. He graduated from The Tactical Aircraft Maintenance Crew Chief "Mission Ready Airmen" course, Luke AFB, Arizona, in March 2001. His background includes flightline and back shop maintenance experience on multiple airframes, having served in multiple leadership positions at the Squadron, Aircraft Maintenance Unit and Flight level. His assignments encompass four MAJCOMs with bases in California, Texas, Georgia, Alaska and the Republic of Korea. Sergeant Reed was selected to perform a special duty assignment as a Military Training Instructor and was awarded the Master Military Training Instructor "Blue Rope" in 2007. Chief Master Sergeant Reed has also deployed for combat operations in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL.

Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Superintendent, 31st Test and Evaluation Squadron (ACC), Edwards Air Force Base, California.
