DLIELC Holds Parade for Veteran's Day: On Nov. 9, 66 DLIELC military and civilian staff and international military students (IMS) staged a drive-by/parade at the Grandview Residence of Westover Hills. Participating IMS and staff carried flags and signage honoring veterans. One of the honored guests was Retired Air Force Master Sgt. Bynum, a centenarian and one of the last surviving Tuskegee Airmen. The veterans shared stories of World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, and the cooperation that was required for success. This event provided participating IMS with a sense of how the U.S. attempts to support and celebrate the great sacrifices of veterans in our society.
