## **DLIELC Moves Forward in Partnership with US Coast Guard:**

DLIELC is working in collaboration with U.S Coast Guard Force Readiness Command, and the US Army TRADOC to develop a Tri-Service Memorandum of Agreement in order begin an ESL program for the USCG at DLIELC in FY22. A delegation of USCG personnel will visit the DLIELC on 5 May 2022 to do a campus tour and meet with project stakeholders. The effort seeks to support 30-50 students per year who require English as a Second Language as part of the USCG accession process. This program would not only assist in the recruitment and retention of diverse individuals to the USCG, but would also improve the overall language

skillset of the USCG personnel. As Air Force Executive Agency to English language training, DLIELC Is prepared to support US military partners in training needs.
