### WALTER H. FRANK

#### MAJOR GENERAL, AIR CORPS

#### Commanding General, Air Service Command

Major General Walter H. Frank, Air Corps, Commanding General of the Air Service Command, became affiliated with Army aviation more than 25 years ago, as a Captain of Infantry; he accepted appointment as Major in the Aviation Section, Signal Corps, on November 4, 1917, and was assigned to duty with the Training Brigade at Kelly Field, San Antonio, Texas. However, the General's military career had started some years prior to his beginning as an airman. Incidentally, since joining the predecessor of the Army Air Forces during the first World War, the General has earned the ratings of Command Pilot, Combat Observer, and Technical Observer.

General Frank was born at Humphrey, New York, April 23, 1886. His graduation from the U. S. Military Academy on June 10, 1910, and his appointment as a Second Lieutenant of Infantry was followed by his assignment to duty at Plattsburg, New York, where he performed company, battalion, and regimental duty until August, 1913. For the next two years he was stationed at Madison Barracks, New York, following which he served a tour of duty for three years at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii.

Upon his return to the United States, General Frank was stationed on the Mexican Border for several months, and he was then assigned as student at the School of Arms, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, where he remained until his transfer to the Aviation Section, Signal Corps. He received his promotion to First Lieutenant July I, 1916; to Captain, May 15, 1917; and to Major in the fall of 1917.

General Frank's stay at Kelly Field was brief, for on November 22, 1917, he entered upon his duties as Executive Officer at Ellington Field, Houston, Texas. He served as Commanding Officer of this post from July 19 to November 5, 1918, in the meantime taking the regular course of flying training. He passed the required flying tests and received the rating of Junior Military Aviator, effective August 29, 1918. His administration of the Bombing and Gunnery



School at Ellington Field brought him high commendation from the Chief of Air Corps.

In December, 1918, General Frank was transferred to duty in Washington and assigned as Executive of the Training Section, Office of the Chief of Air Corps. From June to August, 1919, he was placed in charge of an extensive Air Service Campaign, the success of which attested to his high executive ability. For several months he served as a member of the Advisory Board, and in November, 1919, he was detailed as a student at the Air Service Engineering School at McCook Field, Dayton, Ohio. Following his graduation on September 15, 1920, he returned to Washington and was on duty in the Office of the Chief of Air Service as Acting Executive Officer from October 10, 1920, and as Executive Officer from November 29, 1921, to September 22, 1924.

Assigned to duty as student at the Air Service Tactical School at Langley Field, Virginia, General Frank was graduated in June, 1925, and from the Command and General Staff School, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, in June of the following year. He continued his connection with school work, being assigned as Assistant Commandant of the Air Corps Tactical School, and he performed this duty as well as that of instructor, until his detail as a student at the Army War College in August, 1930. His graduation from this institution in June, 1931, was followed by a period of duty for four years in the Plans Division, Office of the Chief of the Air Corps.

On August 17, 1934, he was assigned to the Command of Mitchel Field, L. I., New York, and of the Ninth Observation Group. He was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel January 1, 1935.

By the time America entered the second World War, General Frank's high professional attainments and experience in connection with Air Corps maneuvers and tactical functions were being used to good advantage in the Air Corps and in July, 1942, he was named Commanding General of the Air Service Command in the European theater of operation. After directing the establishment of important maintenance and supply installations in England, the General was ordered to the United States to become Commanding General of the Air Service Command.

General Frank has served in an executive capacity in various Air Corps maneuvers, and the manner in which he performed his duties brought him high commendation from his superiors. On numerous occasions he delivered lectures dealing with the tactical functions of the Air Corps, which also brought forth expressions of high praise.

# HISTORY OF THE AIR SERVICE COMMAND

×

Air Service Command is the largest of the nine commands in the Army Air Forces, and rightfully so because it is tackling the largest job in the pattern of Victory. Air Service Command's mission is to supply and maintain United States military airplanes wherever they are in use the world over to "Keep 'Em Flying."

Predecessor of Air Service Command was the "Field Services Section" of the Engineering Division of the Air Corps, organized in 1919. The Command's formal history began with the formation of the Provisional Air Corps Maintenance Command, under the Materiel Division, on March 15, 1941. On April 29, 1941, this name was changed to Air Corps Maintenance Command and the unit remained under the jurisdiction of Materiel Division.

On October 17, 1941, the rapidly expanding outfit was given the name of Air Service Command—its almost unlimited scope of service thus appropriately recognized. As a separate command, ASC became a component of Army Air Forces in the Army reorganization of March 9, 1942.

From such humble beginnings, the Air Service Command has grown to its present size wherein it exceeds America's largest industrial corporation in volume of business done, in number of employees, and in the amount of space required to perform its operations. The world struggle for air supremacy, on which victory hinges, has brought about this military reorganization unique in the annals of the United States Army.

First Commanding General of ASC was Major General Henry J. F. Miller, who was transferred to the European Theater of Operations in November, 1942, and replaced by Major General Walter H. Frank, who organized Air Service Command functions in the combat zone during the period July-November, 1942.

General Frank's assumption of command brought farreaching streamlining of Air Service Command operations, characterized notably by the application of proved American industrial-management methods to the operation of Air Supply and air maintenance duties.

Air Service Command accomplishes its mission through the medium of 11 "Control Area Commands" in the continental United States, and through mobile organizations known as Air Depot Groups, Service Centers, and Service Groups in the overseas theaters of operations.

Each Control Area Command is determined by the location of a control depot, and in turn this control depot has a network of specialized depots in its geographical iurisdiction. The control depot cities are: Rome, New York; Middletown, Pennsylvania; Fairfield, Ohio; Warner Robins, Georgia; Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; San Antonio, Texas; Ogden, Utah; Spokane, Washington; Sacramento, California; and San Bernardino, California.

This modern building houses the heart and brains of the Air Service Command. From its busy offices go directions and plans for the successful operation of depots and sub-depots set up at strategic points across the country and in theaters of operation overseas. Here, the men and women soldiers-in-mufti do their part in the big business of Keeping 'Em Flying.





Twenty-four hours a day there is a steady flow of traffic in and out of repair hangars as ships of all types are serv-iced by skilled mechanics of the Air Service Command. Puddlejumpers, trainers, cargo ships and bombers receive equal and careful attention from the home front soldiers in overalls who Keep 'Em Flying.

Here, in summary, is what the Air Service Command does:

I. It furnishes supplies for all Army Air Force airplanes throughout the world.

2. It repairs, overhauls or rebuilds these same planes, here and overseas.

3. It trains the personnel required for the supply and maintenance jobs.

4. It processes (prepares for shipment) all American and Lend-Lease planes for shipment overseas.

5. It gives final inspection to and makes any needed changes or repairs on all American planes flown overseas.

6. It makes final inspection of Lend-Lease planes consigned to South and Central American countries and furnishes supplies, routes and other assistance for the flight from this country to each plane's destination.

7. It handles all air freight in this country flown by the Air Transport Command, its functions being similar to those of a railway express company.

The heart of the Air Service Command is its supply system through which our fliers and planes all over the world get the supplies they need. Bolts and bombers, bullets and bombs, fuel and lubricants, flying suits and jungle kits, radio sets and medical supplies—all are made available by Air Service Command to our Air Force combat units wherever they are found. The minute an Air Force plane leaves the factory it "belongs" to the Air Service Command—that is, from then on it is the job of ASC to keep it in fuel, bullets and bombs, and repair.

The function of the Maintenance Division is to keep planes in combat condition. The lives of our fliers and the effectiveness of our planes depend in large measure on how well the Maintenance Division of the Air Service Command does its job.

"We are the garage mechanics of the Army Air Forces," said Major General Clements McMullen, Chief of the Division. "Without the services of our men and machinery, a plane could operate only so long as nothing serious went wrong with it. In combat, that wouldn't be very long."

Air Service Command mechanics not only restore damaged planes to their original condition; they also make improvements on them. This is called modification, and consists of altering a plane as a result of combat experience. Modifications are intended to fill the gap between the time the Army Air Force decides on an alteration and the time the factory can put the change into effect. Perhaps a section of plane is found to be too vulnerable to enemy fire; that is corrected by installing guns in a certain spot. Or the armament already there may be of insufficient striking power so the machine gun is replaced by a cannon. Again a certain type of plane, such as a P-38, is found ideal for photographic missions, whereupon machine guns are removed from a certain section of the plane and cameras are installed in their place. Thanks to these modifications, the enemy frequently is caught off guard.

While the daring deeds of our fliers have been told over the radio and in the press, very little is known outside the Air Service Command's own ranks of the long hours of toil and hardship put in by the men on the ground in order that the men in the air may carry out their mission in top-conditioned planes.

It is the job of the Personnel and Training Division to supply and train the men and women who operate the Supply and Maintenance Divisions and the other activities of the Air Service Command.

The enlisted men and officers constituting the military personnel of ASC are furnished through Selective Service and the War Department. Consequently, supplying that part of ASC's personnel presents no difficulty.

Air Service Command's training program falls into two broad classes—for its civilian and its military personnel. Civilians are trained for work in this country; the military for work in combat zones. The two groups are trained separately, and their training is different.

The soldier-mechanic in a combat zone isn't likely to be working in a large concrete or steel repair shop where supplies and equipment are abundant, where the plane to be worked on is brought right to the worker, and where the worker has only his single special job to perform. As likely as not, the overseas soldier-mechanic may have to help locate a plane that crashed not far behind the enemy line. When he finds it he must be careful that booby traps have not been planted in it. He must get the plane aboard a wrecker and hauled to where it can be worked on, at the same time he keeps on the alert for snipers and enemy action. He may have to make repairs in a truck hidden under a tree. If no trees can be found, he may have to help put up camouflage to protect the plane, truck and squadron during repairs.

When the enlisted men come to the Air Service Command they have already had specialized training in the work they are to do for ASC. Most of them have been to one of the Army's technical training schools where they learned the fundamentals of their job. That is, they have been taught to be mechanics, woodworkers, welders, etc. It is up to ASC to form them into units and give them unit training.

During the first phase, squadrons are formed. Officers are assigned, and the soldier-mechanics are given basic military training. They are taught how to live in the open—to pitch tents, build latrines and other sanitation devices, fire the weapons with which they will be equipped, protect themselves against gas attacks, run the oostacle course, and render first-aid treatment. During this period, the officers assigned to each squadron are making an inventory of their men to determine which man is best suited for each of the jobs to be performed and to weed out those who can't make the grade. At the same time motor, finance, signal, medical, quartermaster and ordnance detachments are being formed and given their basic training.

In the second phase of training, the soldier-mechanics and the various detachments which trained separately during the first phase are now brought together. This is now a full group, just as it will be overseas. The two months of the second phase are spent in learning how to work together as one self-contained unit.

For the third and final phase of training the soldiermechanics and their detachment move to another location and join up with a combat group. Here are the fliers and the planes they are to serve—the reason for their training. For two months the soldier-mechanics do the same kind of work they will be doing in the theaters of operation—or as like as simulated warfare can make it. Planes have to be put in top-notch condition for bombing missions; crashed planes must be located and removed, sometimes under enemy fire, always in danger of it; all buildings, equipment and men must be concealed, under trees if possible, usually under painted netting or other tricks of camouflage; and repair jobs

To teach officers how to set up shop in theaters of operations overseas the Air Service Command conducts a postgraduate course at the Warner Robins depot, Macon, Georgia. A large sand table shows the layout of a complete ASC set-up in a theater of operations. When the "shove off" order actually comes, each unit commander knows how to handle the thousand and one things necessary to move men, supplies and equipment to a distant post.



To speed delivery of vital equipment and supplies, the Air Service Command operates an air express service called the 39th Air Freight Wing, with air freight terminals at 117 points along the Army's 50,000-mile air transport system in the United States. In emergencies, overseas supply lines are maintained by shipments of vital materials handled by the Air Transport Command. Wherever men and women of the United Nations work and fight, ASC cargo ships roar across the skyways with goods and guns.



must be done with mobile equipment or, if a major overhaul job must be done, the wrecked plane must be hauled to the nearest air depot group, which is equipped for such jobs.

At the end of six months' training under the Air Service Command, the soldier-mechanic is ready to be sent overseas. There he will become a member of a depot group, a service group, or a mobile unit or squadron.

An air depot group corresponds to a main depot in this country. It is more or less a permanent installation and is located from 400 to 1,200 miles behind the lines. It is the supply base for the Army Air Forces for an entire theater of operations. Repair shops are equipped to do major overhaul jobs.

About midway between the depot group and the enemy line are the service groups, which correspond to sub-depots in this country. A service group serves as a supply base for the mobile units or squadrons which fan out from it, and its camouflaged repair outfit is equipped to handle all but major overhauls.

The mobile units or squadrons operate only a few miles behind the line and are intended to furnish emergency service to Air Corps planes and fliers. Each mobile unit consists of from 12 to 20 men, each a specialist in his field. Some are welders, some sheetmetal workers, some machinists, some aircraft mechanics, and so on. The unit is trained to work as a team, the same as a bomber crew.

Army Air Forces and Lend-Lease planes from this country are flown overseas or shipped stripped down or crated. The Air Service Command has a hand in all three methods.

Bombers are flown from factory to a jumping-off place in this country where they are refueled and given a final check-up by ASC mechanics. Some fighters have been flown across, but because of the limited gasoline capacity of a fighter and the strain on the pilot to fly and navigate without the aid of a crew, this has been done only in an emergency or to gain experience. Fuel requirements can be met by fastening an auxiliary tank (belly tank) to the under side of the fuselage which is released when the tank has been drained.

As a rule fighters are shipped across. Some are crated at the factory and addressed and put aboard ship at the port of embarkation by the Air Service Command. Most fighters are stripped down at an ASC embarkation depot and then put aboard ship. Air Force commanders overseas prefer to receive the planes stripped down because they can be made ready for combat in less time than planes that have been crated.

The Air Service Command overseas ports not only process all fighter planes sent overseas, but also handle all plane parts and Army Air Forces supplies and equipment shipped overseas.

Not all of our Lend-Lease planes leave the Western Hemisphere. Many of them go to the other American republics. Most of these planes are trainers. There are also some combat planes. They are flown by Air Transport Command from the factory to San Antonio, Texas, where Air Service Command takes them over.

ASC workers paint on the planes the insignia of the country to which they are going, give the planes a final check-up and make necessary changes, and then turn them over to the accredited representatives of the country of destination who arrange for the personnel to fly them away.

Air Service Command furnishes the fliers with spare parts they may need along the way.
